

Each tarot image correspond to a number. Under each image is an explanation of the image's meaning, symbols, life-time personality and yearly growth symbol. Just click on the small icon and a larger image will come up with all information under it. Each of us has a numerological number that we were born to, and the numbers correspond to one of the major arcana images. You can find your Lifetime Personality Symbol and your Yearly Growth Symbol

How to determine your Lifetime Personality

Add together your birth year, month, and day. See examples below.

1955 Birth Year
3 Month
22 Day

1980

$(1+9+8+0) = 18 = \text{The Moon}$

1956 BirthYear
9 Month
9 Day

1974

$(1+9+7+4) = 21 = \text{The World}; (2+1) = 3 = \text{The Empress}$

In this case you have a personality number of 21, The World, and a spirit number of 3, by adding 21 together, which is the Empress. Like the above number 21, in many cases people have more than one number for their Lifetime Personality. Another sample would be the number 19.(The Sun). In this combination the #19 is the personanlity number. Then you add $1+9 = 10$ (The Wheel of Fortune), which is your Lifetime spirit number. Then add $1+0 = 1$ (The Magicain), which is your Lifetime creativity number. The lifetime personality explanations apply to the spirit number and creativity number.

If you come up with the number 22, it reduces to 4 and also becomes 0.

In numerology 22 is the number 4 ($2+2 = 4$) and also the number for 0 ($2-2 = 0$).

In this case your personality number is 0, The Fool, and the number 4, The Emperor, is the soul spirit symbol.

If your final total number comes out higher than 22, reduce it to a single digit.

Example 1976 $(1+9+7+6) = 23$ $(2+3) = 5$ The number 5, The Hierophant, is your lifetime personality symbol.

How to determine your Yearly Growth Cycle

Add together the current year, your birth month, and birth day. This growth cycle begins on your birthday of each year.

If your final total is 21 or less do not reduce the number. If your total is 22 or higher, reduce to a single digit.

Example:

2006 Current Year
12 Month
24 Day

2042

$(2+0+4+2) = 8 = \text{Strength}$
